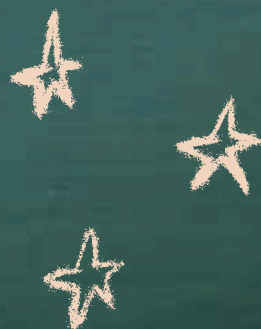


After school clubs

Facebook groups


New groups will be advertised with links on the current facebook groups in the coming days. Please keep your eye out. The old groups will be deleted on 12th September

If your child is in Year 3-6 and you wish for them to be able to walk out of school this year details will be coming out via email soon.



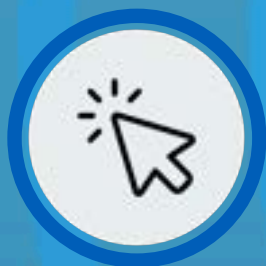
PE days
